

WHY ARE WE LOOKING FOR THE TEMPLE?


- The temple was destroyed in 70 AD and all attempts to rebuild it, thus far, have failed.
- But God's word clearly indicates that another temple would be rebuilt in the last days—when the Jews were again regathered to the land of Israel...
- Consequently, people have been trying to determine its former location in anticipation of seeing it rebuilt



ISRAEL REGATHERED IN THE LAST DAYS

Then it will happen on that day that the Lord will again recover with His hand the second time the remnant of His people who will remain, from Assyria, Egypt, Pathros, Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath,

and from the islands of the sea. — Isaiah 11:11

- The first regathering was with Ezra and Nehemiah when the temple was first rebuilt (c. 516-409 B.C.)
- The phrase "a second time" is OUR TIME and "on that day" refers to the Last Days.



THE PROMISE TO REBUILD

The Lord rebuilds Jerusalem; He gathers Israel's exiled people. – Psalm 147:2

Then the nations around you that remain will know that I the Lord have rebuilt what was destroyed and have replanted what was desolate. I the Lord have spoken, and I will do it.' -Ezekiel 36:36



IN BOTH THE OLD & NEW TESTAMENTS

 In the book of Ezekiel (ch. 45-48), a temple is described that seems best understood as being built during the millennial reign of Christ.

Then the nations will know that I the LORD make Israel holy, when my sanctuary is among them forever. – Ezekiel 37:28

 And we are told that God's temple will also be profaned by the Antichrist in the last days.

He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God. – 2 Thessalonians 2:4

WHERE WAS THE JEWISH TEMPLE?

On the Temple Mount

- 1. The Dominant Belief: at the Dome of the Rock location
- 2. NORTH of the Dome (at the Dome of the Spirits)
- 3. SOUTH of the Dome (at the al-Kas Fountain)
- 4. City of David
- 5. Various other spurious proposals

Very poor evidence that it could have been outside the Temple Mount

THE TESTIMONY ABOUT THE EAST GATE

Ezekiel 44:1-2

Then the man brought me back to the outer gate of the sanctuary, the one facing east, and it was shut. The Lord said to me, "This gate is to remain shut. It must not be opened; no one may enter through it. It is to remain shut because the Lord, the God of Israel, has entered through it."

ALL THE TEMPLE GATES WERE ALIGNED

 This is seen in the design of the tabernacle and the temple described in Ezekiel, all of which are a copy of the heavenly temple/tabernacle.

They serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven. This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain. – Hebrews 8:5

The Mishnah records this as well.

One should not show disrespect to the Eastern Gate, because it is in direct line with the holy of holies. – Mishnah Berakhot 9:5

FURTHER COMMENTARY SHOULD ERASE ANY DOUBT

All of the gates were aligned with one another: the eastern gate (the Golden Gate - the eastern gate of the outer sanctuary), the gate of the ezrath nashim (Court of the Women), the gate of the ezrath Yisrael (Court of Israel), the entrance of the Ullam (Entrance Hall), the sanctuary, and the holy of holies—in the days of the First Temple. - Commentary on Mishnah Berakot 9:5 by Rabbi Bartenura (c. 1445-1515)





These monolithic gateposts may have been part of the earliest wall section of the Temple Mount walls. Even if they were inserted at a later date, it follows that as no remains of any other pre-Herodian eastern gateway are known, the site of the Golden Gate is the only possible location for the earlier Shushan Gate.



A POOR PLACE FOR A GATE UNLESS IT MUST BE ALIGNED WITH THE TEMPLE...




THE SEARCH FOR THE TEMPLE SHOULD BEGIN WITH THE THRESHING FLOOR...







THE CUT FOR HADRIAN'S TEMPLE





WITH TWO JUST LANDMARKS— THE CASE IS CLOSED

- Historic reports and archaeology confirm the ancient origins of the Golden Gate.
- The East Gate was directly in line with the temple, as recorded in the Mishnah.
- A flat piece of bedrock that predates the current platform is directly in line with the Golden Gate-99.93% chance this is no accident!




Alignment of the threshing floor and Golden Gate

And He said: "Son of man, this is the place of my throne and the place for the soles of my feet. This is where I will live among the Israelites forever."



EAST AND SOUTH GATES SURVIVED


And now the Romans, judging that it was in vain to spare what was round about the holy house, burnt all those places, as also the remains of the cloisters and the gates, two excepted; the one on the east side, and the other on the south; both which, however, they burnt afterward.

-- Josephus, Wars of the Jews (6,5,2)









BEST PARTS OF JERUSALEM SPARED

Now, as soon as the army had no more people to slay or to plunder... Caesar gave orders that they should now demolish the entire city and temple, but should leave as many of the towers standing as were of the greatest eminency; that is, Phasaelus, and Hippicus, and Mariamne, and so much of the wall as enclosed the city on the west side. This wall was spared, in order to afford a camp for such as were to lie in garrison; as were the towers also spared, in order to demonstrate to posterity what kind of city it was, and how well fortified, which the Roman valor had subdued.

AFTER THE DESTRUCTION, THE 10TH LEGION STAYED TO GUARD JERUSALEM

But (Titus) permitted the tenth legion to stay, as a guard at Jerusalem... – Josephus, Wars, 7,1,3

ROMAN LEGION FORTIFICATIONS AT MASADA





In Wars of the Jews (5,5,8), Josephus says there was a Roman legion stationed at the Fortress Antonia... but we know from both the New Testament and Roman records that he misspoke and meant a cohort.

The soldiers took Him away into the palace (that is, the Praetorium), and they called together the whole Roman cohort. – Mark 15:16



TEMPLE MOUNT VS. PYRAMID OF GIZA



- The Temple Mount is about 300 m x 475 m x 25 m, this equals 3,562,500 m³
- The largest stone is 13.5 m x 3.3 m x 2 m and weighs over 250 tons!




- The Great Pyramid at Giza has a volume of 2,650,000 m³
- Its largest stone is not more than 80 tons.

WAS THERE "LIVING WATER" ON THE TEMPLE MOUNT?

- Yes. The Temple Mount has millions of gallons of water in interconnected cisterns that were supplied with fresh flowing water (like mikvahs) from two aqueducts, one coming from the Pools of Solomon about 13 km away.
- The Mishnah records that water was brought up from the cisterns using wheels to serve the Temple.

In the chamber of the exile there was a fixed cistern, with a wheel over it, and from there water was provided to all of the courtyard. – Mishnah Middot 5:4


THE ARK WAS BROUGHT UP FROM THE CITY OF DAVID

After David had constructed buildings for himself in the City of David, he prepared a place for the ark of God and pitched a tent for it. – 1 Chronicles 15:1


Then Solomon summoned to Jerusalem the elders of Israel, all the heads of the tribes and the chiefs of the Israelite families, to bring up the ark of the LORD's covenant from Zion, the City of David...


The priests then brought the ark of the LORD's covenant to its place in the inner sanctuary of the temple, the Most Holy Place, and put it beneath the wings of the cherubim. – 2 Chronicles 5:2,7





EXCAVATIONS AT SOLOMON'S STABLES PERFORMED BY JORDANIAN WAQF






WEIGHING THE ARGUMENTS

Prima facie - true, valid, or sufficient at first impression.
Self-evident. Legally sufficient to establish a fact or a case unless disproved.

- Past arguments relied solely on circumstantial evidence.
- It was not believed that there was any prima facie evidence (i.e., landmarks) to establish definitively the temple location...



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
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
